Nova Southeastern University is offering a Therapeutic Pharmaceutical Agents Certification Course (TPA) July, 2010. Seats are limited for the course so early registration is encouraged.

The course will be presented during 14 consecutive days beginning July 8 – July 22nd, 2010 on our Fort Lauderdale campus.

- Part I** - July 8th – July 12th - 50 hours of lecture
Part II - July 13th – July 17th - 50 hours of lecture
Part III - July 18th – July 22nd - 32 hours of workshops, including clinical skills, CPR, grand rounds with patients, and virtual grand rounds
Exam - The exam will be offered at NSU's main campus on August 28th and covers Parts I&II only.
Please Note Part I & II comprise the core 100-hour TPA course. Part III is an optional add on for those optometrists who want an expanded 132-hour course to meet their educational needs and state/province requirements and can be taken as a stand alone course.

Registration Fees

- Part I & II (Core 100-Hour TPA Course) - \$3995 USD
- Part I, II, & III (Expanded 132-Hour TPA Course) - \$5490 USD
- Part III only - \$1495 USD

PLEASE NOTE: A non-refundable deposit of \$995 is due at the time of registration. The balance of the registration fee is due on or before **May 8, 2010**.
